If faced with a casualty who is in the process of receiving an electric shock you should: - Attempt to turn the power off at the mains. - Remove any cables/power tools etc., still in contact with the casualty.

First Aid Treatment For Electric Shock - Health and Safety

First aid measures for electric shock Turn off the source of electricity, if possible. If not, move the source away from you and the person, using a dry, non-conducting object made of cardboard, plastic or wood. Begin CPR if the person shows no signs of circulation, such as breathing, coughing or movement.

The danger from an electrical shock depends on the type of current, how high the voltage is, how the current traveled through the body, the person's overall health and how quickly the person is treated. An electrical shock may cause burns, or it may leave no visible mark on the skin. In either case, an electrical current passing through the body can cause internal damage, cardiac arrest or other injury.

NEVER touch the person receiving the electric shock, or you could suffer one too. After removing the person from the source of electricity, if the person is unconscious call for an ambulance immediately. Only those with the necessary knowledge and skill should carry out first aid.

Electric shock: Symptoms, treatment, and when to seek help

Once the person is away from the source of electricity, check the person's airway, breathing, and pulse. If either has stopped or seems dangerously slow or shallow, start first aid. 5. If the person has a burn, remove any clothing that comes off easily and rinse the burned area in cool, running water until the pain subsides. Give first aid for burns.

First Aid Shock - Health Safety & Environment

An electric shock occurs when a person comes into contact with an electrical energy source.: Electrical energy flows through a portion of the body causing a shock. Exposure to electrical energy may result in no injury at all or may result in devastating damage or death.
